Welcome

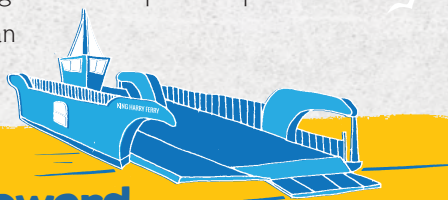

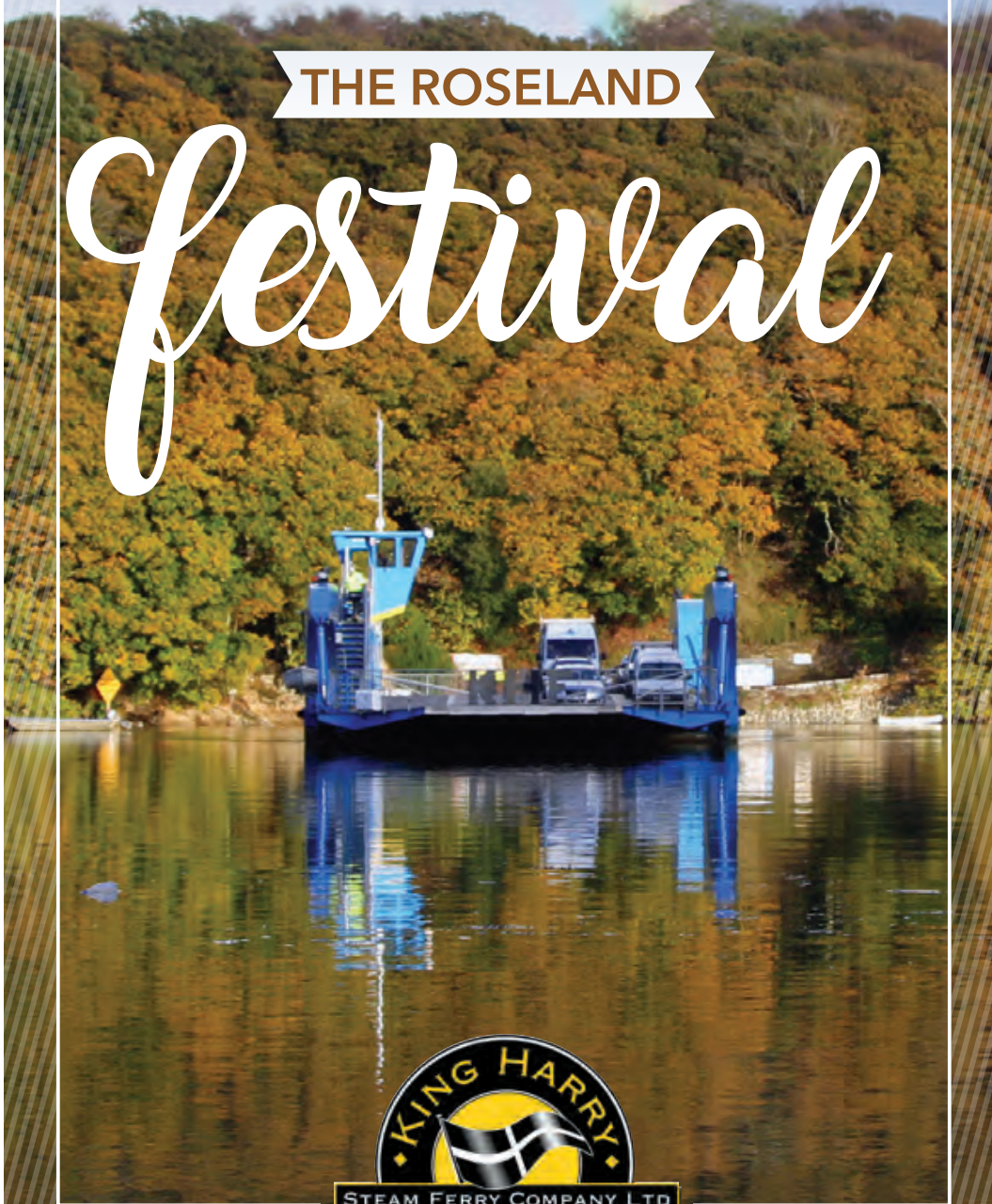
